Sept 12th

Monday. First of these 24 hours blowing hard from the Eastward finished boiling at 5 P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same hands employed stowing down so ends this day

Sept 13th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds finished stowing down at 4 P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same packed & shipped to day so ends

Sept 14th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind & cloudy weather mid & latter parts fine weather lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day

Sept 15th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.E. wind. Boats came on board at 6 P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same lowered the Boats this morning & the B.P. went on & departed at 2 o'clock but did not get fast so ends this day

Sept 16th

Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong breeze from the Eastward. Boats came on board at 5 P.M. mid & latter parts strong breeze lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day

Sept 17th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the Eastward. Boats came on board at 1 P.M. hove up our anchors & floated farther in with the ship mid & latter parts weather the same hands employed in various jobs about decks so ends this day

Sept 18th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours blowing hard from the Eastward mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Monday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong breeze from S.W. mid & latter parts frequent rain squalls so ends

Sept 20th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong S.E. wind with rain mid & latter parts the same took our 2nd anchor to the bow also overhauled the windless so ends this day

Sept 21st

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & Northwardly wind hands busily employed mid & latter parts weather much the same lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day

Sept 22nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & variable wind. Boats came on board at 2 P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same lowered the Boats this morning but the weather came on so bad had to come on board so ends this day

Sept 23rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours blowing hard from S.W. hands employed in various jobs about decks mid & latter parts fine weather lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day

Sept 24th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind. Boats came on board at 5 P.M. mid & latter parts strong breeze lowered the Boats this morning the S.P. departed at 2 o'clock but it was a poor chance did not get fast so ends this day

Sept 25th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong breeze from S.W. mid & latter parts the same so ends this day
