

# Remarks On board B K

Nov 18<sup>th</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind lowered 2 Boats for a Hump back but did not get near them mid & latter parts calm so ends this day Lat 28.50 Long 168.23

Nov 19<sup>th</sup>

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light W wind. B K steering by the wind Land in sight mid & latter parts thick & rainy so ends this day Lat 28.56 Long 168.25

Nov 20<sup>th</sup>

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & W wind. B K steering by the wind Land in sight mid & latter parts weather much the same had one rain squall so ends Lat 29.22 Long 168.26

Nov 21<sup>st</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from W. B K steering by the wind saw a Grampus also saw the Land at night shortened sail mid & latter parts light air hands employed repairing main & B K's main sail finished it so ends no obs

Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>

Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air & calm sent down our fore topsails for repairs & bent other ones saw a Schooner to day at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 29.44 Long 167.53

Nov 23<sup>rd</sup>

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds. B K steering by the wind finished repairing our topsail. Land in sight all day mid part much the same latter part rainy so ends this day Lat 29.38

# Robert. Morrison A D 1881

Nov 24<sup>th</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours hazy weather & westerly wind. B K steering by the wind at night. Philip Island bore N 86 miles distant mid & latter parts fine weather lowered the B. B. this morning & the Capt went on shore so ends this day Lat 29.12

Nov 25<sup>th</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind. B K laying off & on the Boat came off at 5 P.M. the Capt remained on shore took up the Boat & stood off shore mid & latter parts weather much the same sent a Boat in at 8 AM for the Captain so ends Lat 29.07

Nov 26<sup>th</sup>

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & W wind. B K laying off & on Capt came on board at 5 P.M. & brought a Mr. & Mrs. whom he had shipped as 3<sup>rd</sup>. Moate W. Mr. Buffet by name at night shortened sail. B K steering & mid & latter parts frequent squalls of rain & wind so ends this day no obs

Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

Sunday First of these 24 hours. W wind with frequent squalls of wind & rain parted off fore top mast staysail sheet in one of them & the sail blew to pieces before we could get it down & sent it in & bent another one mid & latter parts better weather so ends this day Lat 29.47

Nov 28<sup>th</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & W wind. B K steering by the wind mid & latter parts squally so ends this day Lat 28.53 Long 166.23
