Feb 1st

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fine breeze from the Eastward. B K steering by the wind on port tack mid & latter parts weather the same saw Grampuses to day so ends this day
Lat 32.32 Long 179.35 W

Feb 2nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E wind. B K steering by the wind mid part the same latter part strong breeze so ends this day
Lat 32.19 Long 179.19

Feb 3rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours strong N W wind gamed with ship James. Arnold Capt Chase had taken nothing this season mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
Lat 31.17 Long 179.07 W

Feb 4th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Southward. B K under 2 lower topsails & staysails mid & latter parts more moderate made more sail at 11. and raised. French Rock bearing E so ends this day Lat 31.10 Long 178.56 W

Feb 5th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from N E. B K steering by the wind saw 2 schools of Porpoises mid & latter parts weather much the same at day light raised Curtis rock soon after raised Goat Island so ends this day

Feb 6th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from N E. B K steering by the wind. Leased in sight all day mid & latter parts weather the same the Capt & the 2nd Mate went on shore at Goat Island this morning after Goats. Fish so ends this day
Lat 30.14 Long 178.30

Feb 7th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from N E. B K laying off & on at Goat Island the Boats came on board at 3 PM with 2 Goats & a few Fish. mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 30.22 Long 178.51 W

Feb 8th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Eastward. B K steering by the wind. Leased in sight all day mid & latter parts weather the same saw several Pieces of Squid to day so ends this day Lat 31.25 Long 178.57 W

Feb 9th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Eastward. B K steering by E saw Grampuses mid part weather the same latter part raining. Andrew Cooper came on duty to day so ends no obs

Feb 10th

Friday. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & variable winds. B K steering by the wind mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 32.01 Long 179.40 E

Feb 11

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from the Southward. B K steering different courses mid & latter parts light air & calm saw Porpoises & Grampuses
