March 11th

Thursday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E & E
B K steering by the wind under lower topsails & staysails
mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 32.05 Long 179.40 W

March 12th

Friday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Easterly
wind B K steering by the wind mid & latter parts blowing
a gale so ends this day Lat 32.11 Long 179.53

March 13th

Saturday First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the Eastward
B K laying to under lower mainsail & staysails
mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
Lat 32.34 Long 179.36 E

March 14th

Sunday First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from E & E
B K laying to under close reefed mainsail &
staysails mid & latter parts weather much the same
so ends this day Lat 33.24 Long 179.25 E

March 15th

Monday First of these 24 hours still blowing a gale from the same
quarter mid & latter parts a little more moderate set the
foretop sail & foresail & more ship so ends this day
Lat 34.03 Long 179.08 E

March 16th

Tuesday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E & E
B K under lower topsails & courses steering by the wind
mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 33.26 Long 179.32

March 17th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind B K steering
by the wind on Starboard tack mid & latter parts
weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 32.21 Long 178.18 E

March 18th

Thursday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds with passing
squalls B K steering by the wind heading 8 mid & latter
parts weather much the same stored seawater all day
Lat 31.40 Long 178.03 E

March 19th

Friday First of these 24 hours heavy weather & a fresh breeze
from the Eastward B K steering by the wind on Starboard
tack mid & latter parts more moderate so ends this day
Lat 31.29 Long 177.57 E

March 20th

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly
wind B K steering by the wind heading 8 E & E
saw a white water on our weather bow but never saw
it but once mid & latter parts weather much the same
so ends this day Lat 31.45 Long 179.07

March 21st

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather light variable wind
& calm mid & latter parts Southward by winds B K steering
E so ends this day Lat 31.52 Long 179.23

March 22nd

Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & fresh breeze from
the Southward B K steering E by N mid & latter parts
weather the same so ends this day Lat 31.30 Long 179.23 W

March 23rd

Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from
S E B K steering N E by N lighted French Rock to day
mid & latter parts Easterly wind saw Curtis Rocks &
Island at daylight so ends Lat 30.33 Long 178.34

March 24th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind saw
one Pinback Island in sight all day mid & latter parts weather
much the same raised Boat Island at daylight so ends
this day Lat 29.52 Long 178.44 W
