Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind. B K steering by the wind on different tack mid & latter parts squally so ends this day  
Lat 30.00 Long 179.31 W

March 26<sup>th</sup>

Sunday First of these 24 hours strong Southwardly wind with passing squalls mid & latter parts blowing fresh so ends this day Lat 29.47 Long 179.52 W

March 27<sup>th</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the Southward B K laying to under lower maintopsail & staysails mid part weather much the same latter part more moderate made more sail on the ship so ends this day  
Lat 29.29 Long 179.37

March 28<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday First of these 24 hours strong Southwardly wind B K steering by the wind on starboard tack mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day  
Lat 29.46 Long 179.05

March 29<sup>th</sup>

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Southwardly wind B K steering by the wind Sunday Island in sight mid & latter parts light winds & calms so ends this day Lat 29.19 Long 179.58

March 30<sup>th</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind B K steering by the wind on Port tack Land in sight mid & latter parts strong breeze saw two towers steering to the N.E. so ends this day

March 31<sup>st</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind with passing squalls B K steering by the wind mid & latter parts blowing a gale one sail in sight so ends this day Lat 30.30 Long 179.38 E

Sunday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from N.E. Finished gunning at 6 P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 29.54 Long 179.54 E

April 3<sup>rd</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from N.E. B K steering by the wind under lower topsails foresail & staysails the Adeline Gibbs in sight all day mid part the same latter part more moderate so ends this day Lat 29.42 Long 179.14 W

April 4<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday First of these 24 hours strong Southwardly wind gamed with the Adeline Gibbs to day mid & latter parts weather the same sighted Sunday Island this morning so ends this day Lat 29.43 Long 179.43

April 5<sup>th</sup>

Wednesday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Southwardly wind B K steering by the wind Sunday Island & one sail in sight mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 29.38 Long 179.02 W

April 6<sup>th</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the Southward B K steering by the wind on different tacks one sail in sight mid part light air so ends this day  
Lat 29.40 Long 178.36 W

April 7<sup>th</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather light air from the Southward Sunday Island Boat Island & one sail in sight mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day  
Lat 29.47 Long 178.32 W
