May 31st
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds unskipped our wind less to day & sent it off to have a new one made by it it being too rotten to repair mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

June 1st
Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air hands employed baling out oil mid & latter parts weather the same halled the ship long side the James. Arnold to day so ends this day

June 2nd
Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm employed putting oil on board James. Arnold mid & latter parts rainy so ends this day. George Harding Boat to shore got drunk & made a

June 3rd
Saturday. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather employed putting oil on board James. Arnold mid & latter parts thick rainy weather. Mr. James our 4th officer was hurt by a stick flying & striking him in the face while at work in the hold so ends this day

June 4th
Sunday. First of these 24 hours. Southwesterly winds & rainy weather mid & latter parts blowing the ship at one. And we had slip our fastenings from the James. Arnold done some damage tore off our slide boards & one of the fashion pieces from the stern also tore off one of the Arnolds Davits so ends this day

June 5th
Monday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong N.E. wind mid part the same latter part squally. halled long side the James. Arnold to day & put more oil on board so ends this day

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours blowing free from S.E. at 4.30 halled off from James. Arnold mid & latter parts blowing a gale with heavy rain hands busily employed about decks so ends

June 7th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours strong variable wind with rain hands employed about decks mid & latter parts the same got off. A raft of water from shore to day & showed it away so ends

June 8th
Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly winds took a. Raft of Oil to the James. Arnold to day mid part rainy latter part strong breeze so ends

June 9th
Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather hands employed stowing off the after hold mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

June 10th
Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind mid & latter parts squally so ends this day

June 11th
Sunday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & frequent squalls mid & latter parts passing showers. Port watch went on shore to day so ends

June 12th
Monday. First of these 24 hours Easterly wind & rainy weather mid & latter parts much rain so ends this day

June 13th
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours Easterly wind with heavy rain mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

June 14th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours Easterly wind with much rain not much going on about decks mid & latter parts. Sprung a gale for. B so ends this day. John. Woodwards died last night

June 15th
Thursday. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from. S.E. with much rain mid & latter parts much the same so ends this day
