

Remarks on board B K

Aug 15th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.E. wind cut our whale in this afternoon mid & latter parts strong. Northwardly wind lowered the Boats to day's end.

Aug 16th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong Northwardly wind mid part fine latter part blowing fresh with much rain so ends this day.

Aug 17th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours Southwardly wind with rain commenced to boil our whale to day mid & latter parts strong breeze finished boiling at 2. And lowered the Boats this morning.

Aug 18th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong Southwardly wind the B. B. got a whale to day mid & latter parts strong breeze hands employed stowing down oil so ends this day.

Aug 19th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Southwardly wind finished stowing down at 3. P.M. then cut in our whale & started to boil mid & latter parts strong breeze finished boiling at 1. P.M. at 10 took our Anchor & started for Hongotubeau while heaving up our alter board. Anchor broke both flukes off so ends.

Aug 20th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours N.E. wind & squally weather B. K. tacking by the wind mid & latter parts the same at 10 hours. A.M. came to. Anchor in 12 fathoms water so ends.

Aug 21st

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Southwardly wind mid & latter parts blowing fresh with frequent squalls of wind & rain so ends this day. George Clayson came on duty to day.

Aug 22nd

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. wind with frequent squalls of rain mid & latter parts more moderate lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day.

Aug 23rd

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind. Boats came on board at 4. P.M. mid & latter parts blowing hard with rain so ends this day.

Aug 24th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. wind with rain mid & latter parts the same for gale came on duty to day so ends this day.

Aug 25th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.E. wind mid & latter parts rainy lowered the Boats to day's end.

Aug 26th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours strong variable winds with much rain. Boats came on board at 3. P.M. mid & latter parts better weather lowered the Boats this morning & the L. B. struck & killed a whale & began towing so ends.

Aug 27th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours blowing hard from the Southward tried to get our whale to the ship but was forced to cut from her & let her go the tide & wind being so strong that could not hold up got on board at 12 o'clock at night mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day.

Aug 28th

Monday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Southward mid & latter parts the same so ends this day.

Aug 29th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. wind mid & latter parts the same & whale came close to the ship this morning and the Capt. shot her & set her to spouting blood lowered the Boats and struck her and got her to the ship at 12. M. so ends this day.
