Oct 26th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds mid & latter parts the same. Port watch went on liberty to day so ends this day Joseph Edwards & Walter S. Treater

Oct 27th went on shore to day they are the men that stowed away on board in Bay of Islands

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.E. wind & hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts weather the same as on board watch went on shore to day

Oct 28th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & fine breeze from S.E. mid & latter parts light winds so ends

Oct 29th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds mid & latter parts cloudy weather with light showers of rain so ends this day

Oct 30th

Monday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & S.E. wind mid & latter parts the same at 6 A.M. weighed anchor & came to sea a young white man by the name of and a native came on board to go with us at dark land in sight off our lee quarter so ends this day

Oct 31st

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & somewhat by wind. B.K. steering by the wind heading W.S.W. mid & latter parts squally so ends this day
Lat 21.56 Long 176.16 W

Nov 1st

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours variable winds & passing showers sighted Pilestar Island to day mid & latter part weather much the same so ends this day Lat 22.20 S Long

Nov 2nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a fine breeze from the Eastward. B.K. steering W.S.W. let Andrew Cooper out of Irons to day & sent him forward mid & latter parts heavy squalls of wind & rain shortened sail down to a close reefed maintop sail & staysails & hoisted ship to but it soon moderated made more sail & kept ship on her course let John Brass out of Irons to day so ends this day Lat 22.55 Long 179.14 E

Nov 3rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind B.K. steering W.S.W. mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 22.52 Long 178.44 E

Nov 4th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind. B.K. steering by the wind mid & latter parts calms for gale off duty sick put John Brass in Irons to day so ends this day
Lat 22.36 Long 178.28

Nov 5th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from the Eastward. B.K. steering W.S.W. mid & latter parts moderate breezes so ends this day
Lat 22.51 Long 177.32 E

Nov 6th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from the Eastward. B.K. steering W.S.W. took John Brass out of Irons to day mid & latter parts thick rainy weather so ends this day no obs

Nov 7th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & Easterly wind. B.K. steering W.S.W. mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day
