Feb 12th

Monday. First of these 24 hours thick hazy weather & strong N.E. wind. R.H. steering by the wind mid & latter part weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 36 08 Long 161.34 E

Feb 13th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong N.E. wind. R.H. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts the same at 10 Am raised & fired what's working to windward lowered 3 Boats for them so ends the day

Feb 14th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours haze of weather & strong Northwardly wind at 4 Pm the W. Petrack & killed a whale got him to the ship at half past 6 Am mid & latter parts strong breeze hooked on to our whale at 5 Am and began cutting. Buffaloe Bill came on duty to day so ends this day

Feb 15th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours rainy weather & strong variable wind finished cutting at 2 Pm mid & latter parts much rain started to hail at 5 Am so ends this day

Feb 16th

Friday. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. wind with cloudy weather employed boiling mid & latter parts blowing a gale so ends this day Lat 36 46 Long 161.46

Feb 17th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong N.E. wind finished boiling at 4 Pm mid part weather more moderate latter part fine weather employed stowing down so ends this day Lat 36 36 Long 161.25 E

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northwardly wind finished stowing down at 3 Pm one sail in sight mid & latter parts weather the same saw Grampuses to day so ends this day Lat 35.36 Long 161.39

Feb 19th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather N.E. wind R.H. steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
Lat 36.14 Long 162.11 E

Feb 20th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather Northwardly wind R.H. steering different courses saw Grampuses mid & latter parts strong variable wind with some rain Antonio Rodriguez came on duty to day so ends the day
Lat 36.33 Long 162.18 E

Feb 21st

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours strong Northwardly wind R.H. steering by the wind on Starboard tack mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
Lat 36.35 Long 161.42 E

Feb 22nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather strong Northwardly wind R.H. steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 36.00 Long 162.29 E

Feb 23rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong N.E. wind R.H. steering by the wind on Starboard tack mid & latter parts strong breeze saw a sail steering to the Eastward so ends Lat 35.54 Long 162.14 E

Feb 24th

Saturday. R.H. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
