

Remarks On board R H

March 11th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong S W wind with frequent squalls mid & latter parts Westerly winds so ends this day Lat 33.52 Long 168.05 E

March 12th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind. R H steering E. at all sail mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 34.01 Long 171.03 E

March 13th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly wind. R H steering E. saw one Pinback mid & latter parts light wind & calm sighted the three Kings at daylight. Sailing E by N from us so ends this day Lat 34.06 Long 171.58 E

March 14th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours light S E wind. R H steering by the wind. Three Kings in sight also saw Pinbacks & Porpoises mid & latter parts variable winds & squally so ends this day Lat 33.46 Long 172.21 E

March 15th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind at night 3 Kings bearing 25 miles distant mid & latter parts calm so ends this day Lat 33.49 Long 172.41 E

March 16th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwardly wind. R H steering E & E saw plenty Pinbacks mid & latter parts the same sighted North Cape of N. Y. at daylight. R H steering along the Land with by the wind so ends this day Lat 34.47 Long 173.49

March 17th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E wind at 8 P.M. kept off for Honganai and came to Anchor at half past 10 P.M. in 18 fathoms water. Capt went on shore at 8 A.M. so ends this day

March 18th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E wind hands employed in various jobs moved their ship in nearer towards the shore the 2nd Mate Mr. Thomas & Mr. Evans went on shore to buy several soap so ends

March 19th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong S W wind. Capt & one Boats crew on shore came on board at 5 P.M. sent a raft of water on shore for water so ends

March 20th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather got off our water & stored it down mid & latter parts weather the same employed storing off the two end decks so ends

March 21st

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong S E wind employed repairing blocks & rigging mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

March 22nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northwardly wind mid & latter parts the same at 11 A.M. took over Anchor and went to sea so ends this day

March 23rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong S W wind. R H steering N E by E at dark. Honganai bore S W 30 miles mid part the same latter part rainy so ends

March 24th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours S W wind with much rain. R H steering E. N E mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 33.49 Long 175.39

March 25th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong S W wind. R H steering E. N E mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
