Cet 31<sup>st</sup>

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.W. wind. B.K. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts calm so ends this day  
Lat 28.20 Long 168.27 E

Nov 1<sup>st</sup>

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm mid & latter parts the same so ends this day  
Lat 28.19 Long 168.28 E

Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly wind. B.K. steering S.W. wind. Perpoises & sea muzzes mid & latter parts weather much the same at daylight raised. No fish Island bearing S.W. kept ship for it so ends this day Lat 28.48

Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind. Light went on & down at 2 P.M. Boat came right off, took her up & down of. Where mid & latter parts blowing from N.W. with the big sea running at 11 A.M. had a heavy squall from the westward took in all sail but lower main top sail & staysails so ends this day Lat 28.56 Long 167.58 E

Nov 4<sup>th</sup>

Sunday. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the westward. B.K. laying to under lower main top sail & staysails mid & latter parts blowing a gale from S.W. so ends this day Lat 29.06 Long 168.19 E

Nov 5<sup>th</sup>

Monday. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from S.W. B.K. laying to on Starboard tack mid & latter part weather more moderate at 5 A.M. wore ship & made sail so ends this day  
Lat 28.54 Long 167.56

Nov 6<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & E wind. B.K. steering by the wind on Port tack working up to the land mid & latter parts weather the same went W. Boat on here at 9 A.M. so ends this day no Obs

Nov 7<sup>th</sup>

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Easterly wind. B.K. laying off on Port tack came off at 3 P.M. with 6 Bags. Potatoes mid & latter parts fine weather got off. Potatoes to day so ends this day Lat 29.18

Nov 8<sup>th</sup>

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind. B.K. laying off on mid & latter parts weather the same got off. Potatoes to day saw one shark steering to the Northward so ends this day  
Lat 29.17 Long 167.18

Nov 9<sup>th</sup>

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.E. wind. B.K. laying off on mid & latter parts light wind & calm. Boat went ashore this morning so ends this day  
Lat 29.12 Long 167.17

Nov 10<sup>th</sup>

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind. Mid part the same latter part strong. W.W. wind. Light came off at 11 A.M. with a man that he had shipped and a small. Beef cutter the man's name is Frank Evans kept ship off. Boat so ends  
Lat 29.13 Long 168.02

Nov 11<sup>th</sup>

Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong W.W. wind at 5 P.M. shortened sail & luffed to the wind mid & latter parts cloudy so ends this day no Obs

Nov 12<sup>th</sup>

Monday. First of these 24 hours strong W.W. wind with rain at 5 P.M. took in all sail but Main top sail & staysails mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 28.58 Long 168.12
