Jan 15th
 Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from NW hands employed boiling mid & latter parts blowing & gale cooled down at 5 P.M. so ends this day Lat 35.45 Long 163.43

Jan 16th
 Wednesday First of these 24 hours blowing & gale from SW at 5 P.M. it moderated started the works again mid part fine weather latter part squally finished boiling at 2 A.M. so ends Lat 35.24 Long 163.24

Jan 17th
 Thursday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from SW with a big sea running saw one sail to the Eastward mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 34.40

Jan 18th
 Friday First of these 24 hours strong N.W. winds with frequent squalls of rain mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 34.06 Long 162.33 E

Jan 19th
 Saturday First of these 24 hours variable winds & squally B.K. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts squally hands employed stowing down oil so ends this day Lat 34.07 Long 162.19 E

Jan 20th
 Sunday First of these 24 hours southerly wind & squally finished stowing down at 2 P.M. mid & latter parts weather much the same Robert & John off duty sick so ends Lat 34.01 Long 161.48

Jan 21st
 Monday First of these 24 hours strong southerly wind B.K. steering by the wind under short sail heading to the west mid & latter parts fine weather saw a school of Grampuses to day so ends this day Lat 33.36 Long 161.16 E

Jan 22nd
 Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwardly wind B.K. steering to the Southward saw Porpoises & Grampuses to day mid & latter parts thick & raining so ends this day Lat 34.49 Long 160.43

Jan 23rd
 Wednesday First of these 24 hours Northwardly wind & thick weather B.K. steering & saw Grampuses & Porpoises at dark shortened sail so ends this day Lat 34.49 Long 160.49

Jan 24th
 Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwardly wind B.K. steering & saw Grampuses & Porpoises at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 34.55 Long 161.13 E

Jan 25th
 Friday First of these 24 hours Northwardly wind & fine weather B.K. steering & at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts many squalls of wind & rain at day left ship off & made sail so ends this day Lat 35.41 Long 161.20

Jan 26th
 Saturday First of these 24 hours heavy weather at 1 P.M. it came on to blow in heavy squalls of rain with thunder & lightning & lashed up every thing & furl'd it at 4 P.M. it moderated made more sail saw a white water to day at dark shortened sail so mid & latter parts fine weather saw a Brig steering to the S.E. so ends this day Lat 36.28 Long 162.08 E

Jan 27th
 Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light southerly wind B.K. steering by the wind saw a school of Grampuses at dark shortened sail mid part fine weather latter part heavy rain so ends this day Lat 36.35 Long 162.30
