March 26th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind hands busily employed mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

March 27th

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calms fitted over the ship to day mid & latter parts weather the same 4 of the men that went on liberty & have not yet returned get & expect have deserted there names are Andrew Coe, Robert Cofer, J. L. main & Manuel cabin boy

March 28th

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calms employed in various jobs but decks mid & latter parts thick weather Capt came on board to day for a few minutes let several go on shore to day so ends this day

March 29th

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong W. wind mid & latter parts more moderate. Mr. Roney came on board.

March 30th

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong W. wind mid & latter parts weather the same the men that went on shore Saturday all returned to day so ends this day

March 31st

Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind mid & latter parts cloudy the 2nd mate & four men went on shore to day so ends this day

April 1st

Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind hands employed in various jobs Cooper came on board to day mid & latter parts calms so ends this day

April 2nd

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calms hands employed in the rigging mid & latter parts weather the same Scarp. Bartell deserted while on liberty to day but the other men all came off so ends this day

April 3rd

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

April 4th

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind mid & latter parts rainy let 3 men go on liberty to day so ends this day

Saturday

April 5th First of these 24 hours South East by wind & rainy weather our mast came on board to day stood it away mid & latter parts weather the same Jack off duty sick so ends this day Cook & 2 scores

April 6th

Sunday First of these 24 hours rainy weather & variable wind mid & latter parts blowing hard with heavy rain so ends this day

April 7th

Monday First of these 24 hours strong variable winds with rain our men all came off to day except Scarp. Bartell & George Cooper mid & latter parts blowing & gale dropped 2nd anchor at 11 P.M. so ends this day

April 8th

Tuesday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh with much rain mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

April 9th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours frequent rain squalls & variable wind mid & latter parts weather the same so ends

April 10th

Thursday First of these 24 hours S.E. wind & frequent rain squalls mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

April 11th

Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind hands employed in various jobs mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

April 12th

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind mid & latter parts weather much the same Capt. Weston came on board to day for a few minutes so ends

April 13th

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

April 14th

Monday First of these 24 hours light N.E. wind mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day
