

Remarks On board Rk

- May 3rd First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from Saturday the Eastward. Rk under lower topsails heading to the Southward mid & latter parts more moderate made more sail saw a sail heading to the W.E. so ends this day Lat 30.47 Long 157.49 E
- May 4th First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind Sunday with frequent squalls. Rk steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 31.23 Long 158.04
- May 5th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light. W.E. wind Monday. Rk steering E.S.E. by the wind sighted Lord Howe Island to day mid & latter parts fine weather land in sight all day also saw 2. Pinbark so ends this day Lat 31.54 Long 159.10
- May 6th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Tuesday strong Southward by wind. Rk steering E.S.E. by the wind at dark Lord Howe Island bore. W by W 2.5 miles distant mid & latter parts strong variable winds with frequent squalls so ends this day Lat 31.40 Long 162.10 E
- May 7th First of these 24 hours strong & variable winds Wednesday with frequent squalls. Rk steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 31.28 Long 162.32
- May 8th First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind Thursday. Rk steering by the wind on starboard tack mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 30.11 Long 163.01
- May 9th First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly Friday wind. Rk steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 30.31 Long 164.52

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- May 10th Saturday. First of these 24 hours Easterly wind & squally weather. Rk steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 31.23 Long 163.09
- May 11th Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds. Rk steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 32.24 Long 163.57
- May 12th Monday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from W.E. Rk steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts blowing a gale from W.E. with much rain furled fore topsail & foresail at 11 A.M. so ends day Lat 33.19
- May 13th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from W.E. with much rain. Rk laying to on Port tack mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 33.19
- May 14th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from W.W. with passing showers. Rk steering. W by E mid & latter parts blowing a heavy gale from W.W. goosewinged the maintop sail at 4 A.M. so ends this day Lat 33.27 Long 165.32
- May 15th Thursday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & westerly wind. Rk steering W.E. mid & latter parts better weather so ends this day Lat 33.14 Long 166.56
- May 16th Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind. Rk steering. W by E mid & latter parts heavy squalls of wind & rain so ends this day Lat 31.27 Long 167.49 E
- May 17th Saturday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from W.W. with heavy squalls. Rk steering. W by W mid & latter parts moderate breeze and hazy weather so ends this day Lat 29.45 Long 167.56 E
- May 18th Sunday. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & light S.E. winds. Rk steering. W by W mid & latter parts light variable winds & calms so ends this day Lat 28.12 Long 166.36
