June 1st
Sunday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind
R H steering by the wind on star board took at 4 Pm
took in fore top sail & furlled it & wore ship so ends
this day Lat 29 24 Long 166 54 E

June 2nd
Monday First of these 24 hours clear weather & a strong
breeze from E. N. E. R H laying to on Port tack
mid part light squalls of rain latter part fine
weather made sail at day lite so ends this day
Lat 29 53 Long 166 33

June 3rd
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & N. E. wind
R H steering by the wind on Port tack employed
repairing sails at night shortened sail mid &
latter parts weather the same employed repairing
lower main top sail saw a Ring steering to the westward
so ends this day Lat 30 13 Long 166 46

June 4th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light. Part hard
wind. R H steering by the wind heading N. E. and
down upper main top sail main galant sail & jib
for repairs & bent old ones at night shortened sail
mid & latter parts variable wind with much rain
saw a sail steering to the Southward so ends this day
Lat 29 55 Long 171 36

June 5th
Thursday First of these 24 hours variable wind with
much rain. R H under short sail mid part better
weather latter part fine weather & light Southward
wind. R H steering by E saw Fin backs to day
Manual. Al berto came on duty to day
so ends this day Lat 29 22 Long 168 34

June 6th
Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Southward
wind. R H steering by E sighted Phillip Island
at 2 Pm & Norfolk Island soon after at dark shortened
sail mid & latter parts weather much the same
saw one employed repairing sails so ends this day
Lat 29 22 Long 167 53

June 7th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S. E. wind
R H steering by the wind heading in towards the land at
dark shortened sail & wore ship heading off shore saw
Fin backs mid & latter parts weather much the same
so ends this day Lat 29 28 Long 167 41

June 8th
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air
from the Southward. R H steering by the wind on Starboard
tack saw Fin backs & Grampuses & Porpoises sound in
sight all day at dark bearing N. N. E. 25 miles
mid & latter parts calm so ends this day
Lat 29 25 Long 167 15

June 9th
Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm sound in
sight all day saw plenty of Fish. Porpoises & Fin backs
to day mid & latter parts light Southwardly wind
R H steering by the wind heading to the Eastward
plenty of Fin backs & Fish in sight so ends this day
Lat 29 16 Long 168 30

June 10th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind
R H steering by the wind heading to the Eastward
at night shortened sail sound bearing W 25 mi
mid & latter parts strong breeze saw Killers & one
Fin back so ends this day Lat 28 38 Long 168 46

June 11th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Southwardly
wind. R H steering by the wind heading to the
Eastward at night shortened sail mid & latter
parts weather the same at day lite wore ship
heading to the Southward so ends this day
Lat 28 08 Long 169 05

June 12th
Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly
wind. R H steering by the wind heading to
the Southward at night shortened sail mid
& latter parts weather much the same saw
one Grampus & some fish so ends this day
Lat 28 31 Long 169 01
