

Remarks Onboard R.H.

June 13th
Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind. R.H. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts passing showers at 10. Am wind shifted to the Northward kept ship off S.E. so ends this day Lat 28 44 Long 169.24 E

June 14th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.W. Saturday wind. R.H. steering N.E. at night shortened sail & luffed to the wind on star board tack mid & latter parts passing showers so ends this day Lat 29 00 Long 169.17

June 15th
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & about hardly Sunday wind. R.H. steering by the wind on star board tack mid & latter parts light air & calm so ends this day Lat 29 00 Long 169.11

June 16th
Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm Monday at night shortened sail mid part much the same latter part thick & heavy & increasing wind from the Eastward kept ship off W.S.W. until 11. Am then took in fore d'pail & luffed to the wind on Port tack so ends this day no obs

June 17th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours blowing hard from W. Tuesday. N.E. with much rain at 3. Pm wind shifted to westward & blew hard for a short time then moderated some mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 29.05 Long

June 18th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours blowing from N.W. dark Wednesday laying to on Port tack mid & latter parts wind shifted more to westward so ends this day Lat 28 33 Long 169.24

June 19th
Thursday First of these 24 hours blowing from the west as Thursday R.H. laying to on Port tack mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 28 06 Long 169.38

June 20th
Friday First of these 24 hours strong S.W. wind & clear weather R.H. laying to on Port tack wind moderated towards night mid part fine weather latter part equally so. Porpoises & Finbacks so ends this day

June 21st
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly Saturday wind. R.H. steering by the wind leading to the starboard saw plenty of Porpoises at night shortened sail mid & latter parts light air from the Northward R.H. steering S.W. by W so ends Lat 28.28 Long 170.17

June 22nd
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from Sunday S.E. R.H. steering W.S.W. at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts cloudy weather saw plenty of Finbacks & Birds so ends this day Lat 28 45 Long 169.26

June 23rd
Monday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Easterly Monday wind. R.H. steering W.S.W. sighted Phi Lip Island at 4. Pm at dark shortened sail & luffed to the wind mid & latter parts fine weather at day lite wore ship & made sail plenty of Finbacks so ends this day Lat 23.28 Long 168.28

June 24th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.E. wind Tuesday. R.H. steering by the wind on Port tack saw Finbacks & plenty of Birds also saw the land at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather saw a Humpback. Buffalo. Bull off dut pick so ends this day Lat 28 26 Long 167.58

June 25th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable Wednesday wind. R.H. steering by the wind on different tacks at night shortened sail land bore in 40 miles distant mid & latter parts strong Southward wind saw several Finbacks so ends Lat 28 12 Long 168.24

June 26th
Thursday First of these 24 hours strong Southward ground Thursday took in upper top sail main sail & jib mid & latter parts weather much the same at day lite wore ship & made sail so ends this day Lat 27.50 Long 168.00
