all day Saw nothing of any amount the latter part some
winds from all parts of the compass La Ends this 24 hours
in the Lat by obs 41-24 and Long by 67-00

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the Land S & E
with all sail set a Steering E & E and E at 3 1/2 M Saw a
hump back and at 6 Saw 4 Sails and Saw the
land with it cloudy but pleasant employed in
ordinary duties & at 10



A M Spoke *Bryne Ship Montseruna* Allen and at 3 M spoke
Barque Ananta Capt. Winslow all Blue Bedford at the same
time Saw the *Brig Leonidas* garnet off Fall River and Saw
one more bark at a distance get some potatoes and turner
all of them about 36 hours out from *Gohanna* toward
Adobora isle in that Lat 9-25 and L 13-15 at 6 Morning
Sail put 2 reefs in the topsails with it a blowing
strong and part off E & E ends this 24 hours in the
Lat 11-38 Lat 11-37

with all sail out the ship a running off E & E and
with it cloudy all day but very hot with a bright
beardline seen employed in making Sycamths all day mor
ing in sight *Gohanna* left behind Saw nothing at 6
P M took in sail put 2 reefs in the topsails to ends
this 24 hours in the Lat 10-41 Long by obs
28-30

with it pleasant but cloudy with some light Squalls
at 6 P M Shortened sail put reefs in the main topsail
and 2 in the fore and mizen and took in the fore and
mainmast to ends this 24 hours in the Lat of 8-06 and
Long by obs 46-30 East from Greenwich in England & in
