This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the S.E. and E with short hails at 6 A.M. Got all sail with the winded lights at 12 noon Ship a Steering S.W. by S. employed in ordinary duty Saw four backs at 6 P.M. Shortened hails Go Ends this 24 hours in the Lat 3=38 S 54=22

183th

Remarks Tuesday 20th of Sept 1845.

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the S.E. and E with short hails a Steering S.W. and S.W. by W. with it pleasant all day at 6 A.M. Got all sail again employed in ordinary duty Saw four backs Go Ends this 24 hours with short hails in the Lat by obs 4=10 S and Long by obs 54=20 East

Remarks Wednesday 21st of Sept 1845.

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the S.E. and E with short hails a Steering all around the compass at 6 A.M. Got all sail and at the same time Saw a plenty of fish backs & employed in ordinary duty land and at 4 P.M. Saw some 5 or 6 sperm whales crossed and struck one and at 5 got him along and took in hails Saw some whales to the windward some 4 or 5 miles off but too late to chase them Go Ends this 24 hours in the Lat by obs 3=48 South and Long by (obs) 51=20 East from G

Remarks Thursday

22nd of Sept 1845

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the E.S. and S.E. at 12 noon a Steering all day and putting on getting ready to sail at 5 P.M. Started the work with it pleasant all day at 3 P.M. got the whale all in and at 9 had him cut up Saw nothing all day Go Ends this 24 hours in the Lat 3=36 S 54=16

Remarks Saturday 23rd of Sept 1845

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the S.E. with it pleasant employed in boiling with all sail set but the topgallant sails saw nothing but porpoises and yesterday Saw a hails a Steering of S.W. at 6 P.M. took in hails to the fore topmast Go Ends this in the Lat by obs 3=38 and Long by (obs) 54=23 East

Remarks Sunday 24th of Sept 1845

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the S.E. and S.E. a Steering S.W. and E with all sail set Saw four backs employed in putting cask and getting the oil boiled out at 10 A.M. got it all boiled out and washed off the decks &c. Saw cow fish and porpoises Go Ends this 24 hours with short hails in the Lat by obs 3=02 S and Long by obs 59=14 (obs)

187th

Remarks Monday 25th of Sept 1845

This 24 hours begins with light and moderate breezes from the S.E. and S.E. a Steering S.W. and S.W. by W. with short hails on the ship all day a 6 A.M. began to rain the lower held in the main hatch and at 1 P.M. began to run down and at 4 P.M. got it all down Go Ends this 24 hours with light work Lat by obs 3=00 S and Long by (obs) 54=25 E

188th

Remarks Tuesday 26th of Sept 1845

This 24 hours begins with light moderate breezes from S.E. and S.E. Steering S.W. and S.W. by W. employed in Steaming down all day and at 1 P.M. Saw sperm whales and chased them but got nothing we got close on to them and they started at 5 P.M. came on board and at 6 got through work Steamed down 8 3/4 bls Sperm &c. Shortened hails at 6 P.M. a Steering S.W. Go Ends this 24 hours in the Lat by obs 3=00 and Long by (obs) 54=25
