sails employed in ordinary duty - Go Ends this 24 hours
in the Sat South and Long East

all sails again a steering SSE and SE with the topsails

got on board at 8 o'clock 1/2 sails employed in
boiling and saw the ship Peter a boiling again - Go
ends this 24 hours in the Sat by obs S and Long
by obs East
