W S W with it pleasant nothing seen but grasshoppers
all hands employed in ships duties So ends this day in the
L and L W

This day begins with a light breeze blowing from
the N W by W and from that to W S W about 6
P M more ship about 8 past 4 set all hand as
screwing ship all hands employed in ordinary
duties the carpenter at work on the spar and the
copper at work on the stores the cooper at work
So ends this day with ~~the ship~~ in the
in the L L

a stiff breeze blowing from the N N W with the
ship a heading W by N with nothing in sight but
a fine back all hands employed in ordinary duties
and the cooper at work on the spar So ends this day with
in the L L and L

black fish at 4 P M took out water for breakfast

from the E with it pleasant all day with
nothing in sight but a fine back with the
ship a heading S N E and about 1/2 past 3
more ship all hands employed in ordinary
duties and about 6 more ship again So ends
this day in the L L E

This day begins with a stiff breeze blowing
from the N N W with it heavy about 1/2 it rain
with the ship a heading W about 8 more ship
and about 1/2 past 10 more ship again
about 2 raised black fish on west but near
here we heard but got none all hands em-
ployed in ordinary duties So ends this day
in the L and L

This day begins with it cloudy all day with a stiff
breeze from the N with the ship a heading
W S W nothing seen all day but about 1/2
all hands employed in ordinary duties about
1/2 past 6 took in seal with it a blower
