This day begins with it pleasant and the winds blowing from the N.W. and the Ship heading N about 8 AM the water employed in rating yards and at 12 back Ship and heading N to the wind from the N.W. at 2 PM made sailing ship the St. Peters in 10th all day to about 4 PM back Ship to ends this day in the
L. And L. W.

Remarks Sunday 4th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with it pleasant all day and the wind a blowing from the W by N and the Ship heading N by W till about 2 PM raised a school of whales to the windward board and struck 4 and got 3 about 4 got them along side all hands employed in getting them to ends this day in the S, D-34 Southward 37-10' E.S.

Remarks Monday 5th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with all hands cutting in the whales with it pleasant the wind a blowing from the S by W and the Ship heading N by S about 10 AM out there in and made sail and stood along about 10 raised a breach and stood a long fore it but didn't make out what it was at 3 PM washed of in the mast at the same time a Gwal came up at 11 PM and started the fore in the furrow about 5 back in the flying Jib and helped the main top sail and took in the main top sail East to ends this day in the L.

Remarks Tuesday 6th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with it raining and squally all day and the winds blowing from the S by W and from that to S by E the winds blowing from the S by W about 1 PM were Ship from a breach the sun from the S by E and some after were Ship again a boat is put up in the fore and main top sail all hands employed in cutting

Crossing around the Banks and before Spinn
and mowing the Hudson to ends this day in the L. and L.

Remarks Wednesday 7th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with it pleasant and the winds blowing from the N.W. by N and the Ship heading N by S about 10 AM began to rain in the fore and the fore was S. whales made us about 35 lbs about 8 back cut beef and some nothing seen but some whales under the log and struck one but didn't get him about 4 washed off clocks to ends this day in the L.

Remarks Thursday 8th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with it pleasant and the wind light blowing from the S.W. by W and the Ship heading N by E and at 8 AM went over to light to point about 10 back thinking they were Spinn whales the watch blowing and the pots out and at 2 PM set up the Starboard fore topmast back stay all hands employed in ordinary duties - see logs - took in the fore and the fore was S. whales made some Ship the winds N.W. by N and the Ship heading N by S at 4 back out water to ends this day in the L. and L.

Remarks Friday 9th of Feb In D 1848
This day begins with it pleasant with the wind light blowing from the S.W. by W and the Ship heading N by E at 10 PM began to turn the fore busses and do on and from that to getting up the fore topmast back stay all hands employed in tanning about 10 PM the suspension made a new carline at 4 back of decks to ends this day in the L. and L.
