between decks & got through Go Ends  
this day in port

Remarks Sat. meday 3<sup>d</sup> of March 1849  
This day begins with it pleasant all day  
at 8 the watch went on shore at the  
same time went to painting the ship  
at 9 went and got a draft of water the

day in port

This day begins with it pleasant till at 2  
it begins to rain and rained all day at 9 past  
8 went to get water and at 12 got it up and  
hoisted it in they after noon run it down into  
the lower hold Go Ends this day in port

Remarks Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> of March 1849  
This day begins with it cloudy about all day  
at 8 the watch went on shore the watch  
on board took down the main yard down  
to working the trussit bands and then sent it  
up again to of the Starboard watch under  
taking to run away the apt went to look for  
them but could not find them Go Ends  
this day in port

at 8 the watch went on shore at 8  
began to get up the fore rigging and back  
Stays and to down the stays at 6 the  
watch came on board Go Ends this day  
in port

This day begins with it cloudy at 6 o'clock  
of decks at 1/2 past 10 the watch went on shore  
the other watch getting up the main rigging
