This day begins with it cloudy at 6 washed off decks at 1/2 past 4 the watch went on shore the other watch went to painting about the ship at 1/2 past 11 the Capt. went after some cockle shells So Ends this day in port

Remarks Saturday 10th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy at 6 washed off decks at 1/2 past 4 the watch went on shore the other watch a loud firing here crafts at Sun down the watch came on board So Ends this day in port

Remarks Sunday 11th of Mch An D 1849

~~This~~ day begins with it cloudy at 6 called all hands with it windy all day at 1/2 past 10 the Capt went to look for those to that run away So Ends this day in port

Remarks Monday 12th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy and raining at 6 called all hands at 7 got ready for to get under way all hands employed in cleaning up the decks at 4 broke out in cask of bread at 5 raised a school of *Spermocetes* lower and got 1 at 7 got him along side So Ends this day in the L and L

3057

Remarks Tuesday 13th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy all day light called all hands to get ready to cut in the whale after break fast began to cut him in got him cut in about

crusing around the Banks and Self for *Spermocetes* past 12 then raised the fore top sail the crew ship heading N by E the winds blowing from the N all hands employed in cutting and hauling the head So Ends this day in the L

Remarks Wednesday 14th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy and windy all day going with short sail on the ship with the winds blowing from the N by E and the ship a heading N N W all hands employed in minding cutting and furling Nothing seen but porpoises So Ends this day in the L And L

Remarks Thursday 15th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy with the wind blowing from the N and the ship a heading N N W at 1/2 past 4 broke out the to cask of ships the watch employed in minding and cutting at 3 raised land nothing seen but black fish So Ends this day hauling and land in sight in the L And L

Remarks Friday 16th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy all day with the wind N the ship a heading N N W with the watch scrubbing of decks at 1 o'clock took ship then heading E by N nothing but branches land and grass seen at 6 took in sail So Ends this day in the L And L

Remarks Saturday 17th of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it pleasant all day with the wind blowing from the N N W and the ship a heading N at 6 on hand to flying fish to mend it at 1/2 past
