strong and raised breeches so ends
this day with land in sight in the
S And S

out of the fore hole to mend at 10
got out a cask of water at 12 past
10 the breeze came up blowing from

sulphur button at 6 took in sail
so ends this day in the S

E N E the ship a heading S E raised

nothing in the carpenter at work fixing
the drags nothing seen but black fish
and porpoises so ends this day
with cow Island in sight in
the S And S
