This day begins with it cloudy and windy the wind a blowing from the S by E and the Ship a heading S by E with the brig ahead at 10 ran up and then held on the wind again at 12 ran up & raised our Island ran down to it and then ran up fine the wind at 4 p.m. 3 Squads of rain and then rained the fore main and mizen top sail so ends this day with Squalls and raving in the L.

Remarks Sunday 25 of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy with a light breeze blowing from the E to the Ship a heading S by E with the brig to the windward at daylight made sail all hands employed in ordinary duties nothing seen but porpoises black fish and groupers at 4 p.m. Ship and stood along for the brig at 4 p.m. 5 p.m. with her sails this day with our Island in sight in the L.

Remarks Monday 26 of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it pleasant with the brig to the windward with the wind a blowing from the W by N the Ship a heading S by E at 12 p.m. 1 p.m. a barrel of pork the sails were put away the Lambard quarant but the copper at work at 4 p.m. about 10 p.m. 8 p.m. Ship at the same time the brig were down and stood along nothing seen but land porpoises at 10 took down the weather fore top sail & sent it to the foremast so ends this day in the L.

Remarks Tuesday 27 of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it cloudy the wind a blowing from the E and the Ship a heading E by E at 12 p.m. 1 p.m. all hands to get ready to stow down oil at 4 p.m. 1 p.m. raised a sail of our weather fore standing about N by E and we again with short sail on the Ship all day at 12 p.m. 3 p.m. began to show down at 4 p.m. 1 p.m. and then washed of decks nothing seen but a few hawks so ends this day in the L.

Remarks Wednesday 28 of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it about calm all day at 6 made sail at 12 p.m. 4 p.m. the copper went to work. Letting up casks at 12 a little breeze came up blowing from the E by E the Ship a heading W by E nothing in sight but land and a black M. fir at 4 p.m. 1 p.m. sent down the fore to galant yard and sail to fix it at 4 p.m. 1 p.m. took in the sail so ends this day in the L.

Remarks Thursday 29 of Mch An D 1849

This day begins with it calm till about 10 a breeze came up from the W by N and the Ship a heading S by E at 12 p.m. 1 p.m. went to work on the fore top galant sail and yards and copper it went on the casks at 4 p.m. 10 p.m. shifted the main top galant alutins and brass nothing seen but groupers porpoises and a few hawks at 4 p.m. washed of decks at 6 took in the main top galant sail and flying jib so ends this day in the L.
