This day begins with a stiff breeze blowing
from the NW and the Ship a heading NNE
at daylight raised the anchor of ~~mop~~
then tack Ship at 8 broke out down in the

at 11 began to stow down again mending
grenades and repairing the copper at work
bating up cables at 1, washed of decks at 6 took
in the maintop gallant sail and flying Jib
So ends this day in the L

Ross as 23. Fair day, 24th of March 1823.
This day begins with a stiff breeze blowing
from the N.E. and the ship heading W.
at 9 went out water the cooper at work on
the casks and the carpenter at work at 1
sent the fore-top galant yard up and the
sail men set it at a point 3 fathoms up at
1 was hoist of decks nothing down but a
top sail. at 6 took in the top sails and
flying jib so ends this day in the
L and L
