 top galant rigging at report & the carpenter at work fixing
 the Iron Shanks day at 4 broke out a barrel of beef
 and pork then wash of decks Go Ends this day

Remarks Friday 20 of April A.D. 1848

This day begins with it pleasant and with a light
 breeze blowing from the S.W. and the Ship a heading
 W by S at 6 took up the main top sail to mend it
 at 10 made Iron yarn till at 12 o'clock
 at 1 o'clock bent the main top sail and bent the
 other one made it up the top sail put it down in
 the fore hole at sundown of decks Go Ends this
 day in the S. And

Remarks Saturday 21 of April A.D. 1848

This day begins with it cloudy with a light breeze
 blowing from the S.W. and the Ship a heading
 W by S at day light hove down the main and fore
 sails about 8 o'clock out ~~the~~ the main hatch for the
 main top sail at 9 o'clock bent the main top sail and
 bent the other one at the same time raised a
 of our weather beam raising down about report 11
 squared in the yard
 about 1 o'clock came from the E. and W. and westward
 all the afternoon at sundown of decks at 6 took

 in the fore main and main top galant sail and flying Jib

Remarks Sunday 22 of April A.D. 1848

This day begins with it squally and cloudy at report
 5 more Ship with the wind a blowing from the S
 and the Ship a heading W by S with Short Sail on
 the Ship till about report 6 o'clock then made sail at
 report 8 raised breeches of our weather beam at the same
 time raised our Island
 about 1 o'clock in the wind at the same time
 raised breeches ran it in till it was out what
 it was until about 3 o'clock up about 4 o'clock black
 fish barrel down got one got aboard at report 6 took
 in the main top galant sail and reefed the fore top sail
 Go Ends this day with our Island in sight in the
 S. And S.

Remarks Monday 23 of April A.D. 1848

This day begins with the watch a shipping the
 black fish at report 5 more Ship stood along
 till about about 8 o'clock then more Ship again with
 the wind a blowing from the S.W. and the Ship
 a heading W by S the watch a cleaning the hull
 at 10 o'clock fixed out the pots
 about 1 o'clock started the fire at 4 got through then washed
 up decks nothing seen all day at 6 took in sail
 Go Ends this day in the S.
 And S.

Remarks Tuesday 24 of April A.D. 1848

This day begins with it cloudy the wind a blowing
 from the S.W. and the Ship a heading W by S
 at 6 o'clock made sail and stood along all
 day at report 10 raised 2 barrels of black fish of our
 weather quarter
 at report 12 must be work a making Iron yarn all the afternoon
 till 4 o'clock then worked of decks at 6 took in sail
 Go Ends this day in the S.
