400 Remarks Wednesday 25 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy all day with the wind blowing from the N.W. by E and the ship heading S.E. by E at 8 the mate went down in the fore hold to clean it out at 2 o'clock took ship a heading S.E. by E the wind a blowing from the E by S at 4 the carpenter went to work the watch employed in mending yards at 4 washed of decks at the same time put a foreboard on the fore stay at 6 took in sail so ends this day in the S and S

401 Remarks Thursday 26 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy with the wind a blowing from the N.W. by E and the ship heading S.E. by E at 6 made sail at 8 the watch went to work mending yards with the carpenter at work at 10 raised land at 1 o'clock raised a sail and saw island in sight at 2 o'clock took ship with black fish all around us at 4 o'clock of took at 5 o'clock with the hope at 6 took in sail so ends this day with land in sight in the S and S

402 Remarks Friday 27 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy and windy with the hope to be raised at 6 made sail with the wind a blowing from the N.W. by E and the ship heading S.E. by E at 8 o'clock for 10 o'clock at 10 o'clock so went off for the wind the barque the same with the watch a mending yards with the carpenter at work at 4 washed of decks at 6 took in sail so ends this day with land in sight in the S and S

403 Remarks Saturday 28 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy with the wind a blowing from the S.E. by E the ship heading S.W. by E with the hope to the windward all day at 6 made sail at 8 o'clock went to work mending

Saw 4-068 Spun yarn with the carpenter at work Long 3-4-396 at 3 o'clock took in sail at 4 o'clock washed of decks at 5

raised a school of Spinn whales of our low low lot cutter at the main for the barque to come down lowered down but got worse at 8 o'clock the boats got our lowered at the same time took in sail so ends this day with whales and the barque in sight in the S and S

404 Remarks Sunday 29 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it pleasant with the wind a blowing from the S.E. by E and the ship heading S.W. by E with the hope of our weather saw with the we thought it was a whale at 8 o'clock raised some whales to the windward and to the seaward about 9 o'clock lowered down the S.D. boat got fast but got away from him then the boats came on board and got their dinner stored along on the floor had taken at 1 o'clock the whale of our low low lot and turned up got him along side and began to cut him in at 4 got him out in then reaped the fore and mizen top sail so ends this day in the S and S

405 Remarks Monday 30 of Apr In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy and squally with the wind a blowing from the N.W. by E and the ship heading S.W. by E with the hope of our weather all day the ship a going with short sail on her at 11 o'clock came ship about 4 a Spinn came up from the North and Eastward the watches employed in cutting and mending nothing seen all day so ends this day in the S and S

406 Remarks Tuesday 1 of May In P 1848

This day begins with it cloudy with the wind a blowing from the S.E. by E and the ship heading S.W. by E at 8 o'clock it rained till about 12 o'clock at 1 o'clock a mending with a school of black fish around the ship
