Remarks Thursday 10 of May A.D. 1848

This day begins with a stiff breeze blowing from the S.E. by S and the ship a heading N.E. with the gear & pointers gain up across our bow at the same time raised a top sail below the trawl toward a standing up for make at 10 past 12 hoisted out a barrel of lee at the same time the carpenter went to work on the wheels at 12 past 12 took out the sails at the fore and main top sail then 12 took in the top gaff sail at 12 past 12 raised a keel to the windward at 12 past 12 took in sail then went to work on the ship to ends this day with a sail in sight
