at 8 P.M. took in the top sail nothing do ends this 24 hours in

sail clear a bark the top sail a sailing sail
nothing employed in mending sail do ends this 24 hours in

pleasant but cloudy at 6 P.M. took all sail on a steering & S
one sail in sight at 8 P.M. saw a vessel pass us to the seaward
shortened sail at 10 P.M. do ends this 24 hours in the
lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the S.E. & S.W. with it
it equalled sail a sail employed in ship's duty & mending sails
breezes in the top sails clear one sail do ends this 24 hours in the
lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

Remarks Tuesday 16th of June Anno D 1849

This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the S.E. & S.W. with it
sail a steering S.W. the same course that we have been a steering
this & on 6 days but at 10 P.M. were ship to the eastward again
frequent rain squalls and thick employed in mending, duty
nothing as usual do ends this 24 hours in the
lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the S.E. & S.W. with it
pleasant employed in broken out of it & at 6 P.M. saw a firing back
a steering S.W. & S.W. that to 8 P.M. with sail set night & day
a carrying sail all the time do ends this 24 hours in the lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

a fitting the old main rigging for the fore part from back to

a steering S.W. courses were ship'd on 8 times clear & poised at 6 P.M.
no took in sail do ends this 24 hours in the lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

Remarks Monday 22nd of June Anno D 1849

This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. & S.W. with it
sail a steering S.W. employed in mending the flying jib & sails
a sulphur bottom shortened sail at 6 P.M. do ends this 24 hours in the
lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East

Remarks Tuesday 23rd of June Anno D 1849

This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the S.E. & S.W. with it
sail a steering S.W. with some rain squalls employed in ship's duty
and were poised do ends this 24 hours in the lat 16° 00' South & long 150° 00' East
