This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the N.E. with all sail set, a steering S.E. & from that to S.W. with it pleasant but cloudy. It ends 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Wednesday 27th of June A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the N.E. with some rain squalls. Short sail pleasant. Some of the time more ship to the N.W. at 8 A.M. saw flying backs. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Thursday 28th of June A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the N.E. with some rain a steering from N.E. to S.W. with the short. Employed in ship & duty at 10 A.M. saw the land & at 8 P.M. went in shore with 12 boats & got 1 stick of wood & one fish. Saw a plenty of turtle on turtles but caught none. On board at 6 P.M. saw some porpoises. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East



Remarks Friday 29th of June A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. & S.E. with all sail set, a steering S.W. the middle part, winds baffling with rain & squalls. Saw nothing. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Saturday 30th of June A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. with it raining & squally. Employed in ship & duty a steering S.W. saw nothing. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Sunday 1st of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with light breezes from the N.W. & S.W. from that to S.E. & a steering S.E. with all sail set, with it pleasant but cloudy. Employed in ship & duty saw nothing. The wind as baffling the latter part. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. & S.E. with all sail set, a steering S.E. & employed in ship & duty saw black fish & porpoises & flying backs the latter part, including the top sails & rain with squalls. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Wednesday 4th of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with light breezes from the N.E. & S.E. a steering N.W. & to E.N.E. with the rain squalls the latter part, pleasant with all sail set, employed in ordinary duty at 6 P.M. shortened sail put 2 reefs in the top sails. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Thursday 5th of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with light breezes from the N.E. & a steering S.E. with all sail set, employed in ship & duty saw nothing. Pleasant but cloudy. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Friday 6th of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with light breezes from the N.E. & S.W. from that to S.W. a steering S.W. & course, with it raining & squally. Employed in ship & duty saw nothing. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Saturday 7th of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. with short, a steering S.E. & S.W. with frequent squalls & rain. Employed in ship & duty saw nothing. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East

Remarks Sunday 8th of July A.M. 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. & S.W. from that to S.E. with the rain squalls. Employed in ship & duty saw nothing. Shortened sail at 6 P.M. It ends this 24 hours in the lat. by Obs. South & Long by Chron. & East
