Remarks Monday 9th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with all sail set a steering S.E. & with it pleasant but cloudy & some squalls & employed in securing ship out till dawn grass-pusses do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Tuesday 10th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with one reef in the top sails a steering S.E. dawn grass-pusses do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Wednesday 11th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with some squalls & sail the latter part rainy dawn sulphur bottoms do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Thursday 12th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with short sail employed in mending sails a steering S.E. some rain dawn porpoises do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Friday 13th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with all sail set some of the time winds baffling with rain the latter part pleasant dawn 3 on isle and sulphur bottoms & do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Saturday 14th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with some sail set a steering in shore at 10 dawn land strong all day employed in mending the fish dawn grass-pusses & at 6 took in sail do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Sunday 15th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the S.E. & pleasant a steering S.E. with one reef in the top sails do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Cruising around the Banks & isle from sperm 1849

Remarks Monday 16th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. with all sail set a steering S.E. & employed in mending sail saw nothing shortened sail at 6 P.M. do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Tuesday 17th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.E. & from that in S.W. with some sail set employed in ship duty at 9 A.M. saw sail pleasant all day do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Wednesday 18th of July 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.W. with it cloudy & some squalls & rain employed in fitting rigging dawn the bark & at 10 dawn land & at 3 P.M. 2 boats went a fishing & caught nothing one boat on shore at dawn is for green & saw porpoises do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Thursday 19th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.W. & from that to W.S.W. & W. with all sail set a steering S.W. & courses & a fitting rigging all with it pleasant do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Friday 20th of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with light baffling breezes from all parts of the compass with all sail set employed in fitting rigging dawn grass-pusses calm the latter part do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Saturday 21st of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.E. & S. with some rain a steering S.W. & W.S.W. with all sail set dawn land & saw a sail employed in fitting the rigging & dawn porpoises do end this 24 hours in the Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East

Remarks Sunday 22nd of July Anno D 1849
This 24 hours begins with moderate breezes baffling from S.E. & S.W. & from that to E.S.E. & S. to a steering S.W. & courses with it pleasant some of the time strong breeze at 10 A.M. spoke the bark half way packet 2.30 11 P.M. saw black fish chased but got none do end this 24 hours in Lat 20° 00' South & Long 140° 00' East
Saw land all day
