Remarks Friday 3rd of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. with us to sail in sight with the copper at work at 9 past 8 A.M. raised cow island at 12 noon and English light at 1 P.M. 900 on our watch and to of the breeze went in to get some fish and eggs at 1 P.M. down the boat's come on board. Moises came under the boat but got some other took in sail. So ends this 24 hours in the Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Saturday 4th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from S.E. with us laying aboard and the English barge to the windward. Boat's raised fired about 9 past 8 A.M. raised cow island then ran of pier at 9 past 10 raised another a had come up with her the cooper and copper at work at 4 raised of deck at 6 P.M. took in sail with 6 sails in sight. So ends this 24 hours in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Sunday 5th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from S.E. with a sail in sight at 8 A.M. More ship about 9 past 2 more ship again at 4 P.M. raised Lewis Island of our weather how at 6 P.M. took in sail. So ends this 24 hours in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Monday 6th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from about E.S.E. and the ship heading I raised a crack of our weather how about 9 past 10 A.M. raised a whale to the windward with Lewis Island in sight and took about a 20 lb cow at 2 P.M. got her a long side got down then cut her in scap'd top sails. So ends this 24 hours with sail in sight in the Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Tuesday 7th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. with it cloudy at day light more ship about the same time raised

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denis Island then ran of piece for cow Island about 4 past 10 I raised a whale of our bow at 9 past 1 P.M. raised away and chased until about 9 past 5 P.M. got fast sound out 2 lines and part of another thing to him till about 8 o'clock in the evening then cut and took in sail about 2 thirds of a line came on board & got this before then took in sail. So ends this 24 hours in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Wednesday 8th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. at day light more ship made sail with cow Island in sight at the same time ran of piece all day with us a sailing the watches employed in clearing up nothing. So ends all day at 1 P.M. got down sailing washed of deck at 6 P.M. took in sail then slept on the wind. So ends this 24 hours in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Thursday 9th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. with it cloudy and with us laying a sack till about sun rise then made sail with it plus and all day with the cooper at work on the cask and the hands at work around the try works at 12 P.M. ran of piece at 1 P.M. the watch employed in stowing the cutting falls away at 9 past 2 P.M. light up on the wind at 6 P.M. took in sail at the same time more ship in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Friday 10th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. with us laying aboard and with it rainy and cloudy all day with the cooper at 10 A.M. raised a line on for it but did not make out what it was at 4 o'clock of deck at 6 P.M. took in sail in Lat South & Long East by Chron

Remarks Saturday 11th of Aug An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the S.E. with laying aboard at 6 A.M. made sail and stood along till about 9 then more ship at the same time broke out water and cask
