part 5 took in sail with it raining So ends
this 24 hours in the S

the main top and main rigging with the upper
at work at the same time the boat went a shore on

time a breeze came up from the eastward then
stood in for the island at 5 saw down the
heat came on board took in sail with
us running free So ends this 24 hours
in the S South by E
