 then we heard just before the boat got up their
 they putted to a 30 lb shot and got him down
 raised him in the air and he was kept did not get
 up to him at 4 p.m. 1 o'clock in the wind at 2 o'clock
 down the brig gun at 3 o'clock at 4 o'clock
 in sail So ends this 24 hours in the S

 This 24 hours begins with it cloudy and much
 wind with the breeze and by in sight at 1 o'clock
 the breeze had been but down after meals but
 got none 4 o'clock 12 o'clock from a sulphur bottom
 but did not get my way to him down ship
 with the breeze blowing at sea down gun at
 with the breeze So ends this 24 hours in the
 S by E by S

Remarks Monday 12th of Nov An D 1849
 This 24 hours begins with a stiff breeze from
 the E by N with 12 sails in sight at 11 o'clock
 the cooper and carpenter at work at the same
 time brought out a barrel of pork and the
 work making a strap at 11 o'clock 12 o'clock
 something to the windward with they thought
 was a gun in the wind and pulled up their
 four of their men nothing came on board but the
 the boat in at 11 o'clock the more ship at 6 o'clock
 in sail So ends this 24 hours in
 the S by E by S

 stiff breeze from S & S with 13 sails in sight
 the wind said and was at 1 o'clock with the

 the flying jib then placed it at 1 o'clock out
 water at 1 o'clock in sail then were ship sailing
 fine So ends this 24 hours in the
 S by E by S

 from the E with it changeable with
 nothing in sight at 11 o'clock 1 o'clock out
