Remarks Friday 23rd of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a stiff breeze from the S by E with a sail in sight - lost report & held down the flying jib to put on another sheet about 12 missed our weather beam at 4 point & broke out water raised an another of our sea beam and bow at 6 took in sail to ends this 24 hours in the S

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Remarks Saturday 24th of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a moderate winds from S by E at day light wore ship at 1 point & raised our island of our weather and a sail of our sea beam about 10 point 10 tooked ship at 2 the carpenter went to work plastering up the tiny work nothing much seen at 4 missed at 6 took in sail to ends this 24 hours in the S

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Remarks Sunday 25th of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a light breeze from the S by E about 8 wore ship with nothing in sight about 9 raised a school of seals of our sea beam the S boat got 1 and the B boat got 1 the mast but fastened and the iron dived the sturboard get up but did not fasten to ends this 24 hours in the S

Remarks Monday 26th of Nov An D 1849
This 24 hours begins with nothing in sight a sail to the leeward manoeuvring round to get them out in then wore ship all hands were layed in cutting and minding about 10 a rain squall came up at the same time raised a horse run for it but did not make out what it was about 9 point 10 took the tiny work about 12 wore ship at the same time the hargue took at 6 took in sail to ends this 24 hours with a sail in sight in the S

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Remarks Tuesday 27th of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a sailing with a sail to the leeward and to other sails to the windward with the davis island in sight about 1 a clock rain squall came on at 1 point 5 gale with the catheers of our report at 1 point 5 gale 10 mts out 10 lbs S ends this 24 hours in the S

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Remarks Wednesday 28th of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a light breeze from the S by E with the catheers in sight at 1 raised another of our weather beam at 4 raised a blow of our sea beam run for it and it was a fine luck then 2 mts made 16 lbs at 9 point 2 raised davis island of our weather beam at 9 point 5 the hargue run of for us S ends this 24 hours in the S

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Remarks Thursday 29th of Nov An D 1849

This 24 hours begins with a light breeze from the W by S with a sail in sight at 8 took ship standing in for the land at 10 raised the island and to other sails in sight at 9 point 12 tooked ship
