Round towards New Holland

12th Sunday commenced along freestone and plants
steering 20° commenced sailing made and latter
falls the same employed at steering down
ends thick damp weather Lat 34. 25
Long 116. 33

13th Monday commenced along freestone employed at sailing
and steering down at 9 AM. Manned sailing took in
the freestone and freestone close kept the main
topmast and fore ends heavy gales from the
Westwards ship steering 20° Lat 34. 38
Long 115. 05

14th Tuesday commenced along gales from 1 PM to 6 PM
made moderate set the freestone and kept steering
20° employed at steering down latter part along
gales took in all sail and close kept the main topmast
trying too ends Lat 37. 48
Long 125. 15

15th Wednesday commenced along gales from the NW
at 4 PM had a meeting on board made part
the same latter part moderate all sail set
steering 20° ends Lat 38. 73
Long 121. 35

16th Thursday commenced along freestone from the NW
and squalls made kept the same set in all sail
lying to with a close kept main topmast latter part
at 9 AM. Manned 3 light sails blowing heavy gales
from the NW ends Lat
Long 123. 35

17th Friday commenced along gales from the NW
with heavy squalls at 6 PM. Meeting on board
at 4 PM in the main topmast got moderate
made part the same latter part moderate
set the main topmast and close kept the ends
Lat 38. 57
Long 123. 37

18th Saturday commenced along heavy gales from NW
at 4 PM had a meeting at 7 PM. Manned sailing took in
the main topmast latter part little more
moderate set the main topmast and close kept the
ship trying too Lat 39. 63
Long 123. 83

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19th Sunday commenced a little made moderate
at 6 PM. Manned steering out the main topmast
made part squalls latter part at 9 PM. at the
freestone Manned repairs at 1 PM. Manned in again
blowing heavy rain Lat 38. 39

20th Monday commenced along gales from the NW squalls
made part wind from the NW made moderate
latter part fine weather road in night had a
meeting in the fore part in the evening ends
Lat 34. 13
Long 123. 13

21st Tuesday commenced fine weather at 2 PM. spoke the
ship Manned of native captain went on board
at 4 o'clock closed with the Manned 3 light
sails from the main and 3 from the Manned 3 light
sails we were latter part of weather 4 light sails in night
Lat 39. 45

22nd Wednesday commenced good weather 3 light sails in night
at 5 PM. spoke the latter Manned of Manned
Manned out 4 light sails and Manned 4 light sails
at 4 PM. 5 o'clock closed with the topmast
which sent it down and closed it with latter part
employed at making a new main topmast
Lat 38. 63

23rd Thursday commenced pleasant at 4 PM. Manned 6 light sails
made part light freestone latter part calm at 11 PM
latter part a squall freestone latter part moderate
at midnight passed a ship sailing in rain
