 Lat 15 obs 20-31 this day see black fish
 Sunday 3rd First part moderate NW St almost calm
 very high back fin back & black part &
 tortoise young brown fish lat obs 23-40 down in sight
 Monday 4th First part moderate breeze NW St
 20 Whales NW St 28 E & SE 15 S later part
 light winds land in sight ship
 Mancelon in company saw fish back turn 13
 & papers Lat 15 obs 22-55
 Tuesday 5th First part moderate with wind NW St
 28 E & SE 15 S light winds very easy sail
 at daylight Cape Lucas bore North 3 leagues
