Employed in killing the
Whale at 4 P.M. succeeded
and at 7 P.M. got the long side
after having Laid 3 oars and
one Lance & 1 harpoon
through the Night by the
Whale at 6 A.M. began
cutting in So End the Day
Lat obs 34 34 N
and Long by account 69 30 W

through the Day Wind S by W
Employed in Cutting in the Whale
at 7 P.M. got all in & made
Sail under Double Reef
