latter part fine weather
Wind S.W. all sail set to
Lat obs 13° 13' N the best advantage

Wednesday
the 27th
33rd out

Begins with fine weather Wind
W.S.W. middle and latter part
light breeze from the W.S.W.
and S.W. Employed in
Coopering the Breech
Lat obs 12° 04' N

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Thursday
the 28th
34th out

Begins with fine weather Wind
S.W. sent aloft the main
Royal Mast and up
all hands Employed in braiding
the Breech and Coopering it
middle part Sailing Remarks
at 8 AM had a boat and
tried the Current found it to
set S.S.E. by E. at the rate
of 1 knot per hour
Lat obs 10° 10' N

Friday
the 29th
35th out

Begins with Light wind from the
W. and Shaving S.S.W.
Employed in Coopering Breech
middle and latter part squally with Rain
Wind from S.W. to South
Lat obs Long about 24° 45' N

Saturday
the 30th
36th out

Begins with squally weather Wind
from S.W. to S.E. Standing to the
S.E. and took and took to the Windward
squally Rainy weather Wind to the S.W.
Lat obs 8° 37' N
Long obs 20° 29' W
