The 6th Wind SSW taken and
4th out Steered to the S. E. Ward
Saw a sail standing to the
S. E. by the Wind through a - m
Night strong breeze and
short head sea at 7 A M took the W. S.
and Double Reefed
top sails Lat 18° 45' N
Long by account 19° 15' W

Sunday The 7th
4th out Begins as usual Wind SSW
and strong breeze under
Double Reefed top sails
standing by the Wind W. S. W.
at 6 P M took to the S. E. by S
at 8 A M took to the W. by S
Wind S W by S
Lat 18° 30' N
Long by account 19° 18' W

The 8th
4th out

Sept 1828
taken to the S. E. Wind
S W by S and head sea
from S. E. by short
middle and latter part setting

4th out

Begins as day Proceeding
Wind SSW standing to
the W. S. W. all sail set
at 2 P M took to the S. E. Ward
through the Night squally
with Rain Wind variable
from S. W. to W
Lat D. R. 18° 13' N.
