 Long obs 38-40 W

Friday
 the 3^d
 Begins with light breeze from
 the S & E Steering S W
 Saw hump back Whales
 Middle and latter part pleasant
 weather Wind from E & E to N E
 Lat obs 29-10 S
 Long obs 39-29 W

Saturday
 the 4th
 Begins with fine weather Wind
 at S & E Steering S W
 at Sun Set obs the variation
 to be 8° 23 E
 Lat obs 31-42 Long DR 41-42

Sunday
 the 5th
 October, 1828
 Begins with fine breezes
 from the S & W
 and thick weather with some rain
 Steering S W by E
 at 8 PM took all a back
 Wind at Sunset took in
 sail and lay by under close
 Reefed main top sail &
 three stay sails blowing
 a strong gale at 6 AM
 made fair Wind at 6 PM
 and more moderate
 No obs sun observed
 Lat DR 33-12 S
 Long DR 43-12 W

Monday
 the 6th
 Begins with strong breeze from
 the S & E Steering S W
 under close Reefed top sails
 Latter part moderate weather
 Lat obs 35-14 S Long DR
 45-38 W
