 Thursday the 19th
 Begins with pleasant breeze from the S.W. steering S.W. by S.
 Bent a new fore sail & got in the flying jibboom
 latter part light breeze from the W.S.W. and pleasant weather
 Lat 18° 38' - 47' S
 Long D R 48° 10' W

Friday the 20th
 Begins with fine weather Wind at W.S.W. Bent a new main top sail and Right Whail and Black feet
 middle and latter part Wind at S.W. and thick weather
 Lat 18° 39' - 38' S
 Long D R 48° 48' W

Saturday the 21st
 Begins with pleasant weather Wind at S.W. Standing to the W.ward middle part calm
 latter part strong breeze from the W. by S. Saw plenty of Right Whails
 Lat 18° 40' - 38' S
 Long D R 50° 18' W
