the 16th

83 out

Begins with more moderate weather
Wind S W on bent the old main
and bent the new one
and muzzed top sail
Latter part strong gails from
S W steering S W
Lat 46° 49' S
Long 57° 14' W

Friday
the 17th

84 out

Begins with moderate breeze
from S W steering S W
middle part light breeze from
the S W taked and stood to the
W S W latter part almost Calm
Lat 46° 33' S
Long 58° 30' W

Saturday
the 18th

85 out

Begins with pleasant weather
and almost Calm
Bent a new fore top sail
at 4 P M light breeze from the
W S W bore ship to the S W
Employed in Repairing old sails
middle part fine breeze S.
from S W Lat 47° 10'
Long 58° 36' W

Oct. 21 1823

Sunday
the 19th

86 out

Begins with fine breeze
from the S W steering S W
at 2 P M S W Sounded
found No bottom with 100 fathoms
at 3 Do Sounded and found bottom
at 40 fms Sand and small gravel
kept up S at 4 A saw a ship
to Leeward standing to the S W
Day Ends with strong gails
which brought us under
close Reefed top sails &
stay sails very short see
from the S
Lat 49° 36' S
Long 58° 30' W

Monday
the 20th

87 out

Begins with more moderate weather
at 10 P M made sail and
at 1 P M middle part strong
Latter part do steering S W
Lat 51° 35' S
Long 58° 36' W
