Monday 27th
 9th out
 Oct, 27, 1825
 Begins with heavy squalls
 from W & W
 took in fore sail & fore
 top sail and lay by under
 stay sails and main top,
 a very heavy bad sea running
 at 6 A M wore ship to the
 S, W. Ward, and split the
 main stay sail in setting it
 latter part more moderate
 set the fore sail reefed &
 fore top sail
 Lat 56-34 S
 Long D R 66-52 W

Tuesday 28th
 9th out
 Begins with a heavy bad sea
 ship labouring very much
 Wind at S W
 with squalls of hail &
 sleet at 8 P M wind at N W
 through the Right Line Brass
 at 3 A M saw Cape Horn
 at 12 meridian it bore
 N by E by Compass D S 2 1/2 mi
