Employed in bracing out the
stow down oil
Lat 35 miles S

February 20
Through the day almost
calm Employed in stowing
down oil in the main hatch
and blacking the benches
on the larboard side
Saw plenty porpoises
Lat 33 miles S

Saturday
Feb 21

First part almost calm
Employed in stowing down oil
Saw a few back mail
Lat 35 miles S

Feb 22

First part light breezes and
fine weather steering S W
Latter part squally
the rain S to S W

Feb 23

Begins with squally rainy
weather steering S W
at 4 P M steered S W
at 6 P M took in sail and hauled
to the S by the wind
Latter part standing to the
S wind pleasant breeze
