Thursday Feb 26 214 out Long obs 124-32	Begins with pleasant weather and light breeze standing to the S at 4 P M went to the Southward, and shortened sail Lat obs 19 miles S
Friday Feb 27 215 out Let the Wack	Begins with fine weather steering to the SW at 2 P M N. W. Latter part S W Saw black fish and squid Lat obs 8 miles S Long obs 124 1/2
Saturday Feb 28 216 out	February 1829 Begins with fine weather and pleasant breeze from E. S. E. steering S W at 4 P M by the wind S. E. Employed in painting ship and sundry other jobs Lat obs 10 1/2 S Long obs 125 1/2 = 13 1/2
Sunday Feb 1 of March 217 out	at meridian tacked to the N W fine weather and pleasant breeze from E. saw black fish. hoisted all the boats with our succeed middle part lay by Lat obs 18 miles S Long obs 128 1/2 = 13 1/2
Monday Feb 2 218	Begins with fine weather and light breeze from S. E. middle part lay by Latter part Steered S W Lat obs 11 1/2 S 30 miles
Tuesday 3 219	through the day light breeze Employed in sundry jobs Lat obs 89 miles S. P. 1 1/2 miles
