April 10 1829
Begins with fresh breezes
Employed in painting the ships then
on board of the crew on shore
on Liberty I myself employed
on shore. Spaiding
at Sun set in going to the shore
to go of found the Liberty men
very much intoxicated and one of
them very abusive to
I started in coming on shore after
getting in the boat which I refused
or which he jumped on shore I
and clinched me after a severe
scuffle with the assistance
of several masters succeeded in
binding his hands & feet and
and took him in to the boat
and with Captain Laidton
went to my ship the man all
the time very abusive to
him & me

after getting on board
he swore he would do no man
duty on board and said he was
not drunk but knew
very well all he did the
night before & then
I have gone to the shore
to consult the Consul what
to do with him
So End of the Day with fresh
breezes one third of the crew
on Liberty

Sat 11th Begins with fresh breezes
2nd out at Sun set all hands on board
through the Night Squally
at 6 A M Called all hands
aft and Red to them the
Shipping Papers and
the Laws of the United States
as in the Ship masters aspect
plagued annual broad
I took with a Cat
then put on his hand Cuffs &
put him below
