

Friday May 1829
The 1st Begins with fine weather
1 day Wind from SSW to SW
2/8 out Standing to the W, wind and all
Latter part Calm on board the
main Topmast and being an open
Lat obs 31-41

Saturday Begins with Calm weather
The 2nd at 2 P.M. a light breeze from
2/9 out S & E then SW
at 6 Do Double Reefed
the top sail, and took in
jib & main sail
through the Night & latter
part of the Day strong breeze &
thick weather cold for the season
Lat obs 32-54

Sunday Begins with strong breeze from
The 3rd S by E steering SW by S
2/8 out under Double Reefed top sail
and Porpoise Day Ends with
pleasant weather Wind S & E
Lat obs 31-46

Monday May 1829
The 4th Begins with fine weather Wind ESE
2/8 out Standing to the SSW
at 4 P.M. took in sail &
wore ship to the NE
at Day light wore ship to the
W, wind and made fair
Wind at Sea, etc.
Lat obs 31-28

Tuesday Begins with strong breeze
The 5th Whetch brought us under
2/8 out Double Reefed Top sail
Wind at SSW
middle part Rainy Wind N & W
at 5 A.M. wore ship to the WSW
and porpoise
Lat obs 31-56

Wednesday Begins with strong breeze from
The 6th N & W steering by the wind to
2/8 out the WSW through the Night
stood to the SE Wind N & W
Latter part strong breeze from
steering to the W wind
169-12 Lat obs 31-48
