 dew from the SSW
 latter part pleasant weather
 Wind from SSW steering W
 Lat 31-9 N Long 174-25 W

Saturd
 The 3rd
 286
 Begins with fine weather
 and pleasant breeze from SE
 steering W and great numbers of
 Clams and other shells on the
 water Day ends with remarkable
 smooth weather and pleasant breeze
 Lat 32 34 N
 Long 173-28 W

Sunday
 The 4th
 287 out
 May ID 1829
 Begins with light breeze from
 Sautte, steering W
 Saw a Turtle and great number
 of shells Portuguese men of war
 latter part thick cloudy weather
 and almost Calm
 No shells *****

Monday
 The 5th
 288 out
 Begins with light breeze
 from SSW steering W
 Saw a school of killers
 and pin backs
 The water almost covered with
 Clams and shells of *Sipunculus*
 at 7 AM saw Whales coming
 at 10 AM landed all the boats
 the harbor boat got lost
 and all met at the same time
 the Whail shore the boat
 Badly and Cop seized the
 Whaling I lost 1 line &
 6 hooks and had 3 of the crew
 hunt Lat 33-2 N
